- Depending on the number of submissions we receive, we may or may not be able to use everyone's material. We will read/watch all submissions and reach out to those authors that we will use for the final performance.
- Do you have some sort of hidden talent that can be implemented into your story? Poetry, spoken word, dancing, juggling, multi-lingual, etc. We'd love to hear about it!
- Please make sure your story maintains HIPAA protocols of patient protection and confidentiality.
